

### For Who?

Children aged 8-13 years with high functioning ASD, Asperger's, ADHD, and similar needs. We are flexible and will consider older children up to the age of 15 based on their level of needs.

### What we do?

The club is mainly about creative play with Bricks, based on the principles of Lego®-Based Therapy which will be provided in a combination of structured and free flowing play.

The aim of the club is to provide a welcoming, safe and stimulating environment that reinforces friendships amongst children and develops their social competence and problem solving skills whilst they engage in something they enjoy.

Children can also enjoy the use of a safe outside play area.
